## Year of the Word 2019-2010

Next Sunday we begin the 'Year of the Word', an opportunity to focus more deeply on the Word of God and the role it plays in our lives. God speaks to us through the Bible, but we can find it hard to listen. During this year there will be several extra ways to deepen our awareness and love of God's Word:

"People of the Word" – on the newsletter from next weekend, we will tell the whole story of the Bible, looking at a different character from Scripture each week, with a question for reflection.



**Quotations from Scripture** for different times and situations in life will be made available for us to take away and pray with.

**Lectio Divina** – During Lent, opportunities to practice this way of praying with Scripture in the parish. More details nearer the time.

**Opportunities for learning more about the Bible**, including some new displays in the narthex and more Bible-related CTS publications being made available.

These are in addition to the regular opportunities to reflect on the Word of God, including the readings and homilies at Sunday and weekday Mass, the weekly NCW Liturgy of the Word on Wednesday evenings, and opportunities for private prayer before the Blessed Sacrament, in which Jesus – the Word – is present. As people of faith we are called to centre our lives on God's Word, letting the God who speaks to us be our guiding light.

As individuals and as a parish, let's take this opportunity to open our hearts more fully to God. If you have any ideas of how we can help you to better understand or appreciate the Word of God, please speak to Fr Andrew.
