## Our first 50 years: 2017-2018

January 2017 brought a change of priests to the parish, as Fr Andrew arrived, taking over the reigns from Fr Loughran and Fr Darren, both of whom moved on to new pastures on the same day. He inherited a parish with plenty going on, including a couple of big projects that were underway: the remodelling of the sanctuary and replacement of the altar, and – on a much bigger scale – the demolition of the old porch and the construction of the new narthex. September 2017 and continued well into the following year. On 1<sup>st</sup> February 2018 the new narthex was officially opened and blessed, even though exterior work was still incomplete. In other events, we began a new project to support families in Syria with ACN, and Bishop Paul Swarbrick took from Bishop Michael Campbell, becoming the Seventh Bishop of Lancaster. Members of the NeoCatechumenal Way celebrated their 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary with Pope Francis in Rome, and two coachloads of parishioners travelled to Liverpool in September 2018 to take part in the Blessed Sacrament procession at the end of the national Eucharistic Congress.

## **Today's Readings**

Our run of feast days has come to its close, and we return to the 'ordinary' Sundays of the year, which means a sequential reading of St Luke's Gospel. We pick up the story at a turning point: Jesus 'resolutely' takes the road to Jerusalem, knowing that death and resurrection awaits Him there. Everything from this point in the Gospel is moving towards that climax. There is an emphasis on following Him (something reflected in the first reading too, as Elisha begins to follow the great prophet Elijah), and a reminder from St Paul not to misuse the freedom that God has given us.
