The Holy Eucharist: Jesus in our midst

Last week's Gospel ended with the Lord's promise: "Know that I am with you always, yes, to the end of time." He fulfils this promise in many ways, but the most certain and most powerful way is the Holy Eucharist. At the Last Supper He told His disciples: "This is my Body; this is my Blood"; the disciples at Emmaus "recognised Jesus at the Breaking of Bread"; the Church has always known that this gift is truly the presence of Jesus among us. For this reason, we worship Him and — if we are blessed enough to

receive Him – we do so only with the greatest care and reverence. Meeting Jesus in the Eucharist brings us closer to heaven, as Pope Saint Pius X taught early in the 20th century: "Holy Communion is the shortest way to Heaven. There are others, innocence for instance, but that is for little children; penance, but we are afraid of it; generous endurance of the trials of life, but when they approach us, we weep and pray to be delivered. Once for all, beloved children, the surest, easiest, shortest way is by the Holy Eucharist."

This Friday is the feast of the Sacred Heart, which is the sign of the Lord's unconditional love for us. It is a day to rejoice in the simple but vital truth that God loves each of us more than we can know.
