# Baptism: gateway to a life of faith



# Focus on... Bishop-elect Paul Swarbrick

On Monday, the feast of Our Lady of Lourdes, it was announced that the Pope has appointed Canon Paul Swarbrick to be the next Bishop of Lancaster.

Bishop-elect Paul, 59, is a priest of the Diocese, currently Parish Priest of Christ the Good Shepherd in Workington. He was ordained priest in 1982 and has served in many parishes, and also spent fifteen years on the missions in Zambia.

He will be ordained bishop in the Cathedral on Monday 9<sup>th</sup> April, at which point he will become the



seventh Bishop of Lancaster. Please remember Bishop-elect Paul in your prayers. Whilst he has a big task ahead of him, he will be able to draw not only on his own considerable qualities, but also on the grace of ordination, the strength of the Holy Spirit, and the help of our prayers in the years ahead. Bishop-elect Paul said, "I beg your daily prayers, your patience and your collaboration; our mission is to make our Lord Jesus Christ more widely known and loved in the Diocese of Lancaster. I draw on the example of so many saints and martyrs, as well as on the witness and memory of my own wonderful parents, grandparents and family. Faced with so much that is unknown and uncertain I am comforted by the presence of the Good Shepherd who has promised never to forsake His flock. I will serve to the best of my ability."
