


THE FIRST SUNDAY OF LENT

Franciscan of the Week: Fr Andrew Apostoli

Fr Andrew Apostoli was one of the original eight Franciscan Friars of the Renewal, which formed in 1987. A man devoted to humbly following Jesus in the spirit of St Francis, he provided much spritual guidance to others. He founded the Franciscan Sisters of the Renewal, some of whom we welcome this week. He died in 2017, leaving a wonderful legacy of faith.
