Today's Solemnity is that of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ or, more simply, Corpus Christi. The doctrine of the real presence of Christ in the Eucharist is based, in part, on today's Gospel passage, 'The Bread that I shall give is my flesh for the life of the world.'

In Holy Communion we receive the Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity of Jesus – he holds nothing back! We should never receive Holy Communion lightly; better to abstain and prepare worthily to receive Jesus, that to receive him in a poor state of Grace.
