Focus on... Pentecost Novena

A novena is nine days of prayer, perhaps for a specific intention or asking the intercession of a particular saint. The idea comes from Scripture: between the Ascension and Pentecost, the Apostles and the holy women, including Our Lady, spent nine days "in continuous prayer" (Acts 1:14) awaiting the coming of the Holy Spirit. Why not think about how to spend those days this year? Between the Ascension and Pentecost, say a prayer to the Holy Spirit each day, asking for a renewal of His gifts in your life. You could use any prayer to the Holy Spirit; here is a suggestion:



Come, Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of Your faithful, and kindle in them the fire of Your love. Send forth Your Spirit, and they shall be created, and You shall renew the face of the earth.

O God, who has taught the hearts of the faithful by the light of the Holy Spirit, grant that by the gift of the same Spirit, we may be always truly wise and ever rejoice in His consolation. Amen.
