Today's second reading is a beautiful canticle – a hymn – in which St Paul speaks of God's plan for our salvation. He tells us that we were chosen by God to be “holy and spotless in His presence” even before the world was made, and that in Christ, the “Beloved”, we are granted freedom and the forgiveness of our sins. God's hidden plan, St Paul says, is to “bring everything together under Christ as Head” – everything on earth and in heaven. So the whole of God's creation will be united under the authority and the loving care of Jesus our Saviour. In any time of uncertainty or worry, or whenever we feel bound or trapped, let us turn to Jesus, the One who grants us forgiveness, freedom, healing and unity with others.

FOCUS ON... St Clare's Birthday

St Clare was born on 16th July, probably in the year 1193 (some sources say 1194), so we celebrate this Monday her 825th Birthday. A good excuse for a parish social! Before her birth, her mother Ortolana, who was anxious about going into labour, heard the Lord promise that a daughter would be safely born to her, “whose rays will illuminate the whole world”. So Ortolana called her daughter Chiara – a name which signifies ‘light’, ‘clarity’. Clare, of course, is the English form of her name. Join us for prayers on Monday at 7pm, followed by a social in the narthex and outside the church, at around 7:30pm.
