Focus on... Helping Families in Syria

Following consultation at the parish meeting and with our school, we have identified a new parish charity project to replace the Hodovo fundraising. We will raise funds for Aid to the Church in Need (ACN) to support Christian families driven from their homes in Syria, providing shelter, food and medical supplies. £2000 raised supports a family for a year. Hopefully we can support several families this year, and we will get feedback from them. We will launch fundraising on **Tuesday 30 May (7pm Mass followed by**
