

Focus on... World Day of Prayer for Creation

This coming Saturday is the annual World Day of Prayer for Creation, institued by Pope Francis to encourage us to pray for the protection of God's creation. In the book of Genesis, God gives humans the whole of creation and puts us in charge of His work. But this call comes immediately after He created us "in His image"; so we



should expect that we must also manage His creation following His ways. This means not destroying or misusing what He has made, but acting as responsible stewards, using appropriately all the gifts that God gives us, but not allowing our greed to exhaust creation to the point that it is damaged. Sadly, we know that our environment faces many challenges – from gas emissions to plastics in the ocean, human activity is contributing to a global ecological crisis.

As a parish dedicated to St Clare, we should have a special concern for the environment, because it has been an important part of Franciscan spirituality – right from the start – to praise God for His creation and to show respect for all that God has placed in our hands. Let us pray fervently this coming Saturday for all of creation, that we may be more faithful stewards of our world.

We have seen many examples of extreme weather in recent months, not least the devastating floods in Kerala. Let's continue to pray for all those affected. Next weekend there will be a special collection at all Sunday Masses for the emergency appeal which has been launched for Kerala. Please give what you can to help.

Adoremus Eucharistic Congress

Liverpool, 7th-9th September 2018

This national event is aimed at deepening our awareness of the presence of Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament, and our love for the Eucharist. Representatives of parishes from across the country will be present, and over the weekend there will be talks, discussions and opportunities for prayer. On the Sunday there is a Eucharistic procession (open to all) through the streets of Liverpool, beginning at 1pm.

Within each parish there will be extra opportunities for prayer over these days. As St Clare's, we will hold the First Friday Holy Hour as usual on Friday 7th at 7pm; then on Saturday, Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament from 10:30am until 6pm, to give us all opportunity to pray before the Eucharistic Lord.
