

# 2016 Calendar Photographic Competition



## THE COMPETITION

St Clare's RC Church, Fulwood is producing a calendar to help raise funds for a new church porch.

The calendar will be on sale from mid September.

We are looking for people to submit photographs to feature in the calendar.

The theme of the calendar is "The Four Seasons".

Submitted photographs will be on display in the Church in August.

Parishioners will be invited to choose their 4 favourite photographs - one photograph for each season.

A judging panel will then pick the winning photographs from those with the most votes.

The judging panel's decision will be final.

If your photograph is chosen, you will receive a free copy of the calendar.

## CRITERIA

Photographs must represent the theme of "The Four Seasons".

Photographs to be in landscape format and can be in colour or black and white.

Photographs to be submitted as A5 size prints.

Photographs must be available in a jpeg or other similar image file with a minimum resolution of 2480 x 3508 pixels.

Submissions deemed unsuitable or inappropriate will be withdrawn from the competition.

All photographs must be your own original work and must not have been published previously.

Images may be digitally enhanced to make them brighter or clearer or to remove spots or scratches but not manipulated.

## SUBMISSION

Please submit entries as A5 size prints and put your name, contact details, where the photograph was taken and which season your entry is for on the reverse of each print.

Prints should be put in an envelope and either handed in to the Clergy/Presbytery at St Clare's or posted to St Clare's Presbytery, Sharoe Green Lane, Fulwood, Preston PR2 9HH.

By submitting a photograph you consent to it being reproduced in the calendar.

Any person featuring in a photograph must consent to the photograph being submitted/reproduced.

You can enter as many photographs as you like however only one of your photographs may be chosen to feature in the calendar.

Entries to be submitted by 31 July 2015. Entries received after this date will not be considered.

No responsibility will be taken for any entries which are lost, delayed or corrupted.

If your photograph is chosen, you will be contacted for an electronic copy.

Submitted prints can be collected from the Church in the first 2 weeks in September. Any uncollected prints will be destroyed.
