


St Clare's Catholic Church **EASTER SUNDAY**16th April 2017

"... and rose again on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures..."

This brief statement from the Creed is actually lifted from St Paul's writings (1 Corinthians 15:4), at the start of a passage where Paul explains that we are all destined to rise again. Christ's resurrection is our hope: without it, we could not have eternal life. But today, as foretold by Scripture, Jesus rose from the dead to a new and glorious life, beginning the new creation promised by God (Revelation 21:1-4). This day is our joy, our hope, our comfort and our salvation. This week's task: pray the 'Regina Caeli':



Queen of Heaven, rejoice, alleluia! For He whom you were worthy to bear, alleluia! Has risen as He said, alleluia! Pray for us to God, alleluia!

Focus ow... Exposition, Reflection, Sung Vespers and Benediction

An opportunity to reflect on the Gospel accounts of the resurrection, to pray before the risen Lord present in the Eucharist, and to celebrate Vespers, the Evening Prayer of the Church. The disciples recognised the risen Jesus in the Breaking of Bread – the Eucharist – so we have the chance to come before Him in prayer, thanking Him for staying with us. Sundays throughout Eastertide, 3:30pm Exposition and Reflection, 4pm Vespers and Benediction.
