


Franciscan of the Week: St Catherine of Bologna

Catherine (1413-1463) was raised in luxury in Bologna, but at fourteen persuaded her whole family to become Franciscan tertiaries. Granted visions of Jesus and Mary, yet also plagued by demonic thoughts, Catherine endured much spiritual suffering. She became a Poor Clare and was abbess of the convent in her home city, a role in which she was noted for her kindness. A writer, poet and painter, she is a patron saint of artists. She was canonised in 1712.
